
WHEREAS, Governor Kemp issued an Executive Order on April 2, 2020, at 3:12 p.m. requiring citizens of Georgia to practice social distancing in accordance with his Executive Order and the guidelines published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and

WHEREAS, the Judicial Emergency Order issued by the Georgia Supreme Court is expected to be extended beyond April 13, 2020, and

WHEREAS, this Court has determined that it is in the best interest of the health and safety concerns of the citizens of Lincoln County and in the interest of judicial economy that trials scheduled for the week of April 27, 2020 be continued,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that trials scheduled to begin in Lincoln County the week of April 27, 2020 are hereby continued to a date to be determined in the future.
